


## To Register for the Parent Portal



Next time you can just log in with your son/daughter/ward's student reference and the password you created.

Once on the parent portal, you can fill in your son/daughter/ward's emergency contact details and the Consent and Indemnity form.

You can also book your son/daughter/ward home for the weekend/overnight using the Planned Visits Home feature.

Their attendance is also shown, listing missed lessons.
